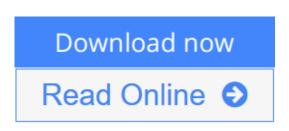

Editorial Review

Emily Dickinson may have spent most of her life in her family home in Amherst, Massachusetts, but she was deeply affected by the wider world and what was going on around her. This two-volume encyclopedia of nineteenth-century historical, literary, scientific, and social events illustrates this point. Editor Martin has put together a compendium of events that happened during Dickinson's lifetime and explores the impact these events may have had on her. The encyclopedia opens with a short biography of Dickinson and descriptions of her written work, which includes letters she wrote to friends and family as well as her poems. Each encyclopedic entry contains a brief discussion of persons, topics, or events linked with Dickinson's writings to show how her life was shaped by the culture around her. While this encyclopedia is inclusive and rich in detail, there seems to be an overreaching quality to the breadth of topics included here. Some entries, such as those on the Civil War or women's roles, make sense to include as these were broad historical and social episodes that stretched into nearly everyone's lives at the time. Others that are harder to make a connection to include animals such as insects and tigers, as well as natural phenomena like volcanoes. The exoticism of both cases seems to make any connection to Dickinson's life a bit strained. A more constrained collection of items that focused more on social and historical events may have served the work's purpose better. Despite this, the entries are well written, and the connections between Dickinson's writings and the world around her are shown with a particular richness. The encyclopedia ends with an appendix containing the first line of all of her poems, indexed by encyclopedia topic. Overall, a very good overview of Dickinson's life and times. This is suitable for high-school and college students and for general readers who are interested in American literature and poetry. --Sylvia Ashwell
